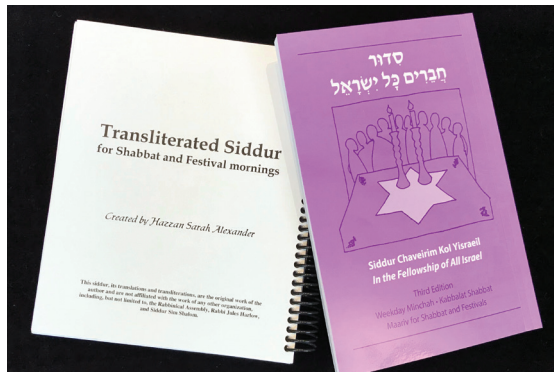
New Prayer books!

Shalom! This summer you will notice a new addition to make our Shabbat services a little bit more “user friendly.” No, I am not talking about “No Tie July” which we have had for the last several years (but I do think that not having ties makes us more user friendly!).

Both our Friday night service and our Shabbat morning service have new additions to our siddur choices. On Friday night we have a brand-new siddur called *Siddur Chaveirim Kol Yisraeil* edited by Mark Frydenberg and Barry Dov Walfish. It comes from the same people who brought us the incredible “Different Night Haggadah.”

This Friday night siddur has Hebrew, English translation and an *English transliteration for the entire service*. So, regardless of one’s Hebrew reading ability, you can follow along for the entire service. The layout is attractive, and there are some brief comments on the sidebars as well.

For Saturday morning services, we have a new Siddur companion called “Transliterated Siddur for Shabbat and Festival Mornings” created by Hazzan Sarah Alexander. This includes Hebrew, English translation and an *English transliteration for the entire service*. Additionally, this siddur corresponds to the page numbers that we use for *Siddur Sim Shalom for Shabbat and Festivals*. This means that there will be no awkward page calling of both books.



Prayer in synagogue can be challenging. The prayers are fixed and don’t always speak to our individual moment of crisis or exaltation. Also, the prayers are in Hebrew, and many of us don’t have fluid Hebrew skills. However, by utilizing a fixed liturgy we also have the spiritual connection with Jewish communities throughout the entire world. By praying in Hebrew, we not only feel connected to our ancestors, but also to our brothers and sisters praying everywhere on earth. Hopefully, these transliterations will help open the door a little bit wider.

When using these, don’t hesitate to sing loudly. Hazzan Ben-Yehuda has a beautiful voice; and it sounds even better when we all sing together. Our hope is that these new publications make the Shabbat prayer experience a little bit more open.

These new prayer books were paid for generously from our Durbin Prayer Book Fund at Congregation Beth Shalom. Over many years, individuals make small contributions to this fund to help the synagogue buy new prayer books when needed. We are grateful to those who have made this possible.

Life Lesson 22: *“It’s not what you look at that matters; it’s what you see.” – Henry David Thoreau*

Your way of thinking may not always be the best way, or even the right way. We walk along on a beautiful spring day. We look at trees, grass, flowers, birds and small animals. We look up and see clouds and blue skies. We talk about what we are looking at, but neither of us sees the same thing. How could that be?

We listen to the sounds of nature, but we don’t hear the same things. We have an argument over some trivial item or topic, but we differ in our opinions. What we hear and what we listen to are open to interpretation. What we look at and what we see are also open to interpretation. Who is right? Is anyone right? Or, is everyone right?

We all are entitled to our opinion. Hebrew scholars have been studying Torah for millennia, but they still cannot agree on their interpretations of the content. Everything in life is open to interpretation. We must accept the fact that we cannot always be right. We must accept the fact that others may have a different view, but they are also right. Ask them if you don’t believe me.

It is our differences that drives our creativity.

Dr. Edward deBono, the father of lateral thinking calls “the need to always be right the biggest bar to new ideas.” He says, “Creativity involves breaking out of established patterns in order to look at things in a different way.”

In 1975, New York City was experiencing a financial disaster and was close to bankruptcy. Crime was increasing, and the city could not afford more police to deal with it. Dr. deBono was called in to help them find a creative way to resolve this problem. And he did. The solution to New York’s problem was to give each police officer six eyes. WHAT! What a stupid idea. But that stupid idea was the birth of the neighborhood watch program. The public became the additional eyes the police needed. He saw things differently.

We must teach our children to be creative. We must teach them not to be afraid to see things differently and act differently, or as that great Star Fleet Commander Captain James T. Kirk said, “...to boldly go where no one has gone before.”

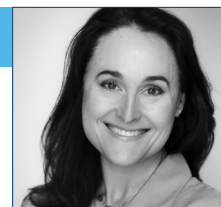

What's Up with the Imahot?

The Amidah, the standing prayer, is made up of several different passages. The first passage is called Avot, which means fathers, or ancestors. It begins *Baruch Atah A-donai, E-loheinu vE-lohei avoteinu; E-lohei Avraham, E-lohei Yitzchak, vE-lohei Ya'akov...* This translates, *blessed are You, God, our God and the God of our fathers/ancestors; God of Abraham, God of Isaac, and God of Jacob.* In many minyanim over the last several decades, we have added the Imahot, the mothers, to that list, namely, Sara, Rebecca, Rachel and Leah. In our congregation, we sometimes add the Imahot, and sometimes we do not. I want to talk a bit about why we do, and why I tend not to when I daven for myself.

There are those who feel that leaving out the Imahot implies that Abraham, Isaac and Jacob were all that were necessary for the beginnings of Judaism – that the wives of these men, the

mothers of Isaac and Jacob, had no role to play. They feel that excluding them from this prayer downplays these women's relationship with God. Excluding the Imahot may suggest that our religion does not value the role of women throughout Jewish history generally, and these first Jewish wives and mothers specifically.

This summer, I am going to dedicate my Scroll articles to my thoughts and approaches to the Imahot. I encourage you to engage me in a conversation about it if you like – I've been thinking about it for years, and I'd love to hear your opinions as well. I think it's deeply personal, and it is very much worth thinking and talking about, since we cannot read minds, and you may assume you understand why another person includes or does not include the Imahot. When you ask them why they do or don't, you may be surprised with the answer they give!

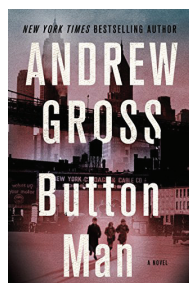
