Hanan Hammer and his wife Natalie are second and third generation members of Beth Shalom, they were even in the same Beth Shalom Kindergarten class, although at that time they were not the least bit interested in each other. After the birth of their daughters, Hanan was asked to serve on the School Committee. After that exposure to the inner workings of the synagogue, he became more involved. He has served as Budget Chairman (more times than he can remember), Administrative Chairman, Scholarship Chairman, Israel Pilgrimage Committee Chairman, kiddush corps volunteer, Treasurer of the Beth Shalom Foundation, Kovod Award recipient, and most recently the Interim Executive Director.
