- Current symptoms of COVID-19, including: Cough Fever (100.4° or higher) Shortness of breath Difficulty breathing Loss of taste and/or smell Chills Muscle or body aches Headache Sore throat Diarrhea/nausea/vomiting Congestion/runny nose Extreme fatigue

To ensure maximum safety and protection, all congregants wishing to attend indoor worship should understand and agree for myself and/or my family member(s):
