The Case

Black-led organizations in KC face inequitable barriers to resources and networks. BridgeSpan, for example, found that net assets of Black-led groups were 76% smaller than the most well-resourced organizations.

A data driven collective impact strategy that is community-led, community-driven, and invests in Black-led organizations. Our model is grounded in racial equity in order to uplift BIPOC communities as a whole.
