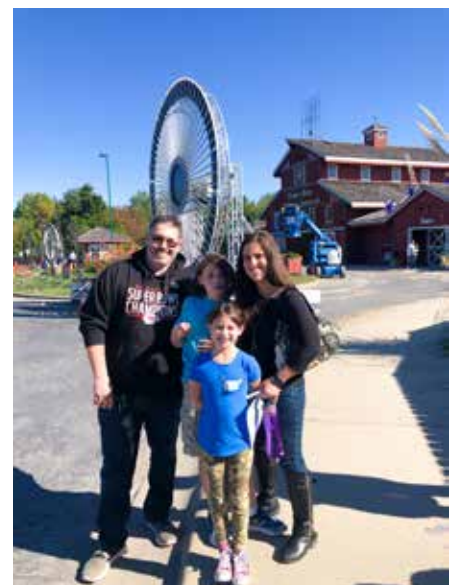

Welcoming refugees from Afghanistan

Beth Shalom Sisterhood's Warm Up America Project (WUA) recently donated 22 handmade, one of a kind, afghans to Jewish Vocational Service to be used to welcome the refugees coming from Afghanistan. Allisa Fortney-Tombaugh, JVS Manager of Resettlement Services and Carol Yarmo, WUA's Project Chairman are shown displaying some of these handmade, beautiful and warm afghans. Each quilt includes a Welcome to America note and each refugee family will be allowed to pick the one they most like. Just as JVS welcomed and helped resettle many of our grandparents and ancestors, JVS is once again taking the lead on this and many of the women of Beth Shalom Synagogue's Sisterhood are proud to be a part of this important endeavor. Over a period of about 10 years, Beth Shalom's Sisterhood has donated 402 afghans to many organizations who then distribute them to people in need. Some of these other organizations include: Jewish Family Services, Wounded Warriors, Synergy, SafeHome, Operation Breakthrough, and many others. We are always looking for people who would like to be a part of this wonderful project. We supply the yarn to be used to knit and/or crochet 7 by 9 inch rectangles (36 in all) to be designed and then sewed together to produce these unique and special afghans. We will be happy to teach (or reteach) you how to knit or crochet!
