Names in our Spaces – The Plaques in Our Sanctuary

In the Jewish tradition, there is sanctity to names and sanctity to spaces. It is not inconsequential that two names we have for God are related to names and spaces. In some religious circles we refer to God as “HaShem,” meaning, quite literally “the name”. This is because we believe that God’s original name as written in the Biblical text is literally ineffable. Another name we have for God is “HaMakom” – literally “The Place.” We use this name when we give mourners the traditional blessing of comfort. We say “May ‘HaMakom’ give you comfort amongst the remaining mourners of Zion and Jerusalem.”

Religious sacred spaces where we remember our loved ones beautifully merge the sanctity of name with the sanctity of space. The names recall memories, and when we invoke the names of our loved ones it is as if we are actually inviting them to spiritually join us in our sacred space. I feel this energy palpably when we have the silent Yizkor meditation at the festival services. I know that I am actually mentioning the name of my loved ones, and my body feels the weight of the silence upon it as everyone there is also mentioning the name of their loved ones.

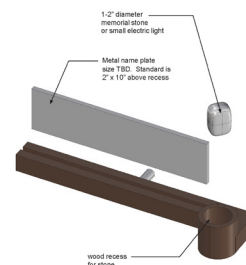
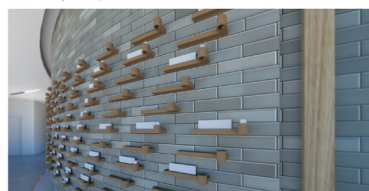
In the back of Goldsmith Hall, we display the plaques of our loved ones each week. This spring, I am inviting you to purchase a plaque for your loved one. They cost \$500, and you can pay by cash, cheque or credit card to order yours. In addition to a beautiful eternal bronze plaque, the purchase of this ensures that for the life of our congregation your loved one’s name will be read aloud in synagogue on his or her actual yahrtzeit before the kaddish.

We often don’t know where we will live, if we will be in synagogue, nor can we ultimately control the religious paths of our children and grandchildren. Memorial plaques preserve the Jewish memory of our loved ones regardless of the turns that life may take.

On the second day of Shavuot for Yizkor, June 6, at 10 am, I will announce the names of those whose plaques have been purchased since Passover. Then, at Shemini Atzeret when we say Yizkor again on , October 17, 10 am, we will have a dedication of these new plaques.

One of the most aesthetically beautiful elements in the new sanctuary will be the memorial wall. It will have an artistic element which will allow us to place a candle or stone next to the plaque of our loved one.
