Berenice Haberman was honored for her contributions to Sisterhood, the synagogue, and the community at Beth Shalom's Sisterhood Torah Fund Luncheon on April 27, 2022.

The luncheon took place at Congregation Beth Shalom's at Goldsmith Hall. Ninety-two people enjoyed a plated lunch catered by Kim Matsil. This year we welcomed members of Ohev Sholom's Sisterhood. Entertainment was by Michelle Cox, Music Director at the Temple Congregation B'nai Jehudah, and Hazzan Tahl Ben-Yehuda. Rabbi David Glickman spoke and updated the attendees on the 5 seminaries that Torah Fund supports. Torah Fund supports the teaching institutions that educate our rabbis, cantors, scholars, educators, summer camp directors, chaplains, campus Jewish life staff, and committed Jewish lay leaders. They are located in New York, Los Angeles, Jerusalem, Israel, Buenos Aires, Argentina, and Potsdam, Germany.

This year, Beth Shalom's Sisterhood won an award from the Women's League for Conservative Judaism for making and surpassing its Torah Fund Campaign goal of \$9000.
