THANK YOU PAM FITE



Youth & Family Programming

The autumn long stream of Jewish holidays has come to a close, and with that we are able to take a moment to reflect on what we have just experienced. As I begin to do that reflection, I can't help but find myself incredibly proud of the high levels of teen engagement within our congregation throughout the holidays!

Rosh HaShanah found many teens attending our services in Goldsmith Hall, the Lower Level Prayer Space, and the Pavilion. Some were teens who are actively engaged in youth programs throughout the year, while many others were teens I was meeting for the first time. Tashlikh also found lots of teens in attendance (and even a few KCUSY alumni who came back from college to celebrate the holidays at home)!

During the time in between Rosh HasShanah and Yom Kippur, KCUSY had Wednesday Lounge Night, where many teens (who although they were exhausted) wanted to come together to share their thoughts on the holidays and be surrounded by Jewish community.

Also during the time in between Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur, Kadima (our youth group for teens in grades 6-8) hosted its kickoff event - a bowling outing, which brought together nearly two dozen teens from within our congregation as well as across the Kansas City area. The kids spent two hours bowling, building community, and filming silly videos!

Yom Kippur brought exciting opportunities for the teens to be involved. Beyond attending our service offerings, a group of teens worked with Hazzan Ben-Yehuda to help lead some of the musical portions of the Kol Nidrei service in Goldsmith Hall (something that the teens had excitedly been talking about for weeks prior)! Additionally, at the conclusion of the final service, members of our KCUSY

board handed out glowsticks to the children (and a few adults that were kids at heart) of the congregation to add a little extra light to the Havdalah service.

KCUSY then hosted our October "Second Saturdays" program, which was in partnership with BBYO and NCSY/ Jewish Student Union. For this program, "Harvest and Havdalah", Jewish teens who are members of various Jewish youth groups across Kansas City joined together for an evening that began with Havdalah and was followed by gardening in the Mitzvah Garden, working in the dark by the light of cell phones and flashlights. We learned about the importance of the work that the Mitzvah Garden does for our community, and by the end of the evening, we had harvested more than 100 pounds of produce!

Teens celebrated Sukkot by gathering together in the Beth Shalom sukkah for "Salsa in the Sukkah", where teens had the opportunity to shake the lulav and etrog and enjoy some chips and salsa with friends. It started to drizzle a little bit, but that didn't stop the teens from wanting to spend time in the sukkah outdoors!

Finally, we had a huge turnout for our Simchat Torah Birthday Bash! Nearly three dozen teens in grades 6-12 joined us in the Youth Lounge for an evening of celebration that included decorating cupcakes and playing games. Following the birthday bash, teens joined the rest of the congregation in Goldsmith Hall for the Hakafot!

We LOVED having so many teens so actively engaged in our programming during the High Holiday season! We can't wait to share the exciting upcoming programming we have for our teens, so make sure to keep an eye out!
