## The Most Important Israeli "High Holidays" In Our Lifetime

**Yom HaZikaron**

**Sunday, May 12 at 6 pm  
White Theatre at The J**

In Israel, the days between Yom HaShoah (the Jewish remembrance of the Holocaust) and Yom HaZikaron (Israeli Memorial Day) with Yom HaAtzmaut (Israeli Independence Day) have a resonance similar to the Days of Repentance between Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur.

During autumn's Days of Repentance, we look toward the new beginnings promised in Rosh HaShanah, and reflect upon our shortcomings as we pray for forgiveness on Yom Kippur. In the late spring, we stand in solemn memory on Yom HaShoah. We remember the lives lost and also reflect on the inability for Jews to physically defend themselves from the Nazis and the willing blindness of the rest of the world toward the Shoah. On Yom HaZikaron, we remember the lives lost to war and terror since Israel's beginnings. On Yom HaAtzmaut, we celebrate the return of Jewish sovereignty to the Land of Israel.

The time in between these poles are also appropriate times of reflection, not unlike the reflection between the days of Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur. This year is a time to reflect upon the costs of both powerlessness and power. It is also a time to think about aloneness and togetherness. For the immediate hours of the attack on 10/7, many thinkers described this as a "black hole," where Israel did not exist – it was a state unable to protect its own citizens. Since the war started, many of our own children have been taunted on college campuses while facing protests.



Many of us have our own heads spinning as we desire an end to Hamas, a release of all hostages, and witness the damage in Gaza. The night of the missile attacks from Iran into Israel gave us a glimpse of what could have been, with simultaneous gratitude for Israel's ability to defend itself and receive help from multiple allied states. In the way that Tishrei is the "address in time" for spiritual feelings of renewal and repentance that we feel year-round, these Israeli holidays are the "addresses in time" to give space to our own reflections on Jewish sovereignty – even if we have been thinking about it for months.

I want to bring to your attention one event that often slips under the radar of the greater Jewish community. Our community has a very meaningful Yom HaZikaron (Israeli Memorial Day ceremony) each year. This year it is being held **Sunday, May 12 at 6 pm at the White Theatre at The J**. For information, you can email [jex@thejkc.org](mailto:jex@thejkc.org).

This ceremony is planned and largely attended by Israeli members of the Kansas City community. While some local Israelis join synagogues, many do not. This is a year when many in Israel lost family members in war, have relatives or friends who are injured physically or psychologically, and may even have friends still captive in Gaza. Even if we don't know someone personally in Israel, we can stand with our community to give them strength at this Yom HaZikaron ceremony.
