Please Join Us for a Unique Shabbat Experience



Legacy (Planned Giving) Gift Committee — Leadership Transition

Financial obligations to organizations are commonly summarized into two categories; short-term and long-term. At Congregation Beth Shalom, short-term responsibilities are currently provided by dues, fundraisers, day-to-day donations, and financial support coming from our endowment funds.

Relative to long-term commitments, Congregation Beth Shalom looks toward interest income derived from the endow-

ment fund and Legacy Gifts from you, our congregants. Legacy Giving contributions are gifts to charitable organizations, left by donors after death, through their wills or estate plans. We are immensely grateful for Legacy Gifts coming from families in our congregation.

A bit of history about our Congregation Beth Shalom Legacy Gift Program:

About 20 years ago, community Jewish philanthropist Stan Bushman donated \$750,000 to assist all local Jewish organizations in establishing and building their own respective legacy gift programs. This tremendous boost was to incentivize each organization to establish specific goals relative to number of legacy gifts and, when met within specific time frames, the organization would receive cash funds during the three different three-year-segments.

Prior to our consolidation with Congregation Ohev



Sholom, both congregations were original participating organizations utilizing Stan Bushman's gift. During the 20-plus-year period, Congregation Ohev Sholom's program had been managed under leadership by Harold Kaseff, Audrey Asher, and Lori Klarfeld and Congregation Beth Shalom's program had been led by Rabbi Alan Cohen, Gary Cortes, Rabbi David Glickman, Harold Kaseff, and Marc Hammer. We are indebted and exceedingly appreciative for leadership of the critical work these dedicated volunteers have given over

the years.

Recognizing importance of the Legacy Giving Program, the Board of Directors of Congregation Beth Shalom incorporated the Legacy Giving Committee into the bylaws as a required standing committee. And now, we are proud to announce that Bob Grant has assumed leadership of the Legacy Gift Program at Congregation Beth Shalom.

Bob's experience traverses financial and non-profit worlds. Bob graduated from Pennsylvania State with a degree in accounting. With a CPA certificate, he later worked in industry and the non-profit world in various management roles. He's served on several boards including Menorah Legacy Foundation, JCRB/AJC, and the JCC where he served as president. In his off time, he mentors non-profit leaders and is assisting Jewish Archives.


