The night will center around the theme "What's Love Got To Do With It? Revelation and Relationship" – exploring the deep connections between love, revelation, and our relationships with each other and with God.

Shavuot, when we mark the giving of the Torah at Sinai, is an opportunity to engage with the teachings and values that shape our lives. This year's Tikkun Leil Shavuot will take you on a journey of spiritual reflection, intellectual engagement, and meaningful discussion – with plenty of fun and cheesecake to keep you awake until midnight (if you so choose).



This Shavuot, we'll dive into the heart of Torah and ask: where does *hesed*—lovingkindness—fit into our lives, and what can law, spirituality, psychology, and music teach us about it? We'll explore how the Torah given at Sinai offers a roadmap for love in action.

The evening will begin with a panel discussion at 8 pm titled *Precedent and Presence: Where Law Meets Lovingkindness*. It will be moderated by Art Federman, retired Federal Bankruptcy Judge and featur-

ing distinguished panelists from the community. We'll head into sessions taught by all three clergy, as well as a session titled *Relationship Revelations: What Shavuot and Couples Therapy Agree On*, taught by Addie Cutler, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist. 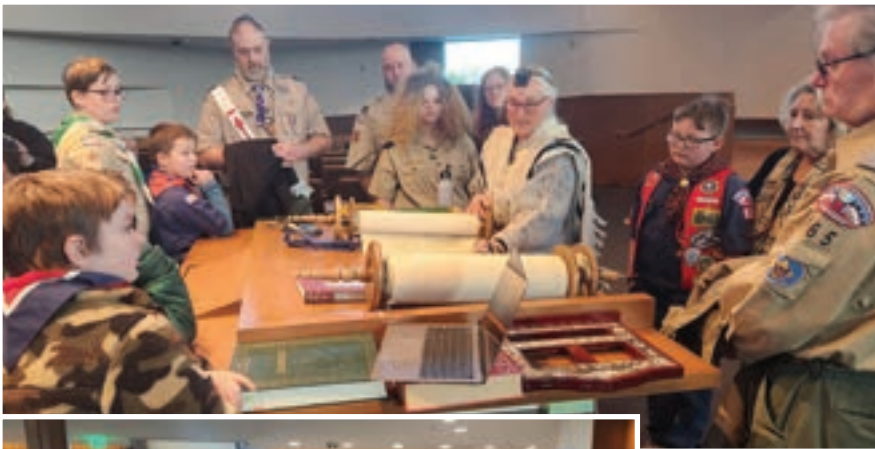

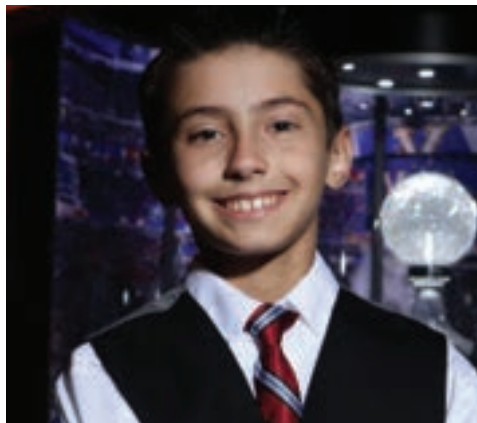
