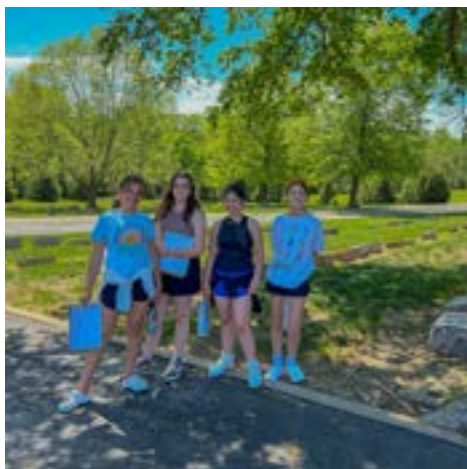

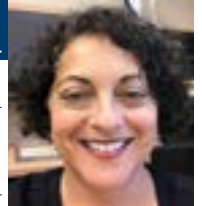

We then had lunch, followed by Chofesh (free time), where teens had the opportunity to socialize, play sports, and enjoy each other's company. After Chofesh, Aviva Clauer led a wonderful program on Israel, which ended with a delicious surprise of falafel for us all to enjoy together! KCUSY teens then helped lead Mincha, followed by free time and "Senior Moments" (a time for the senior class to share their favorite memories from their time in USY). Sitting there listening to the teens really underscored for everyone there just how truly important USY is and how big of a difference it makes in their lives. The regional board then led us in some creative programs, which led straight into a pizza dinner. It was then time for Ma'ariv, Sloach (slow ruach), and Havdalah. Once we said farewell to Shabbat, the regional president delivered her "State of the Region" address. The final program of the night was a Silent Disco! Upon the completion of the Silent Disco, the senior class joined together for their "Senior Late Night", which acts as the final time that their class has to spend time together as a group.

Sunday had three Shacharit options: Disney-themed, Zumba-inspired, and traditional. We transitioned from Shacharit to breakfast, which led into chapter awards! KCUSY was honored to have received THREE chapter

awards from the region. We won "Gesher Program of the Year" for our middle school bowling party. We also won "Best Social Media" for our use of the KCUSY Instagram account, the new KCUSY Photo Dump Instagram account, and for the amazing video blog of the bowling party filmed by Vivien Wishna!
